Main Information:

- Signing on will take place in the circuit restaurant each day from 07:30 (see map on next page)
- Friday 3rd you will receive breakfast and a cooked lunch in the circuit restaurant and a payment of £20
- Saturday and Sunday you will receive breakfast, a packed lunch, and a payment of £10 for each day
- There will be the usual **Club BBQ** on Saturday night, in the Marshals campsite
- Please refer to the map overleaf for information on signing on and camping locations for Marshals
- **IO BRIEFING:** Briefing for all IOs at 08:15 on FRIDAY and SATURDAY morning, where we sign-on.

Parking and Getting to Corner:

As usual, recovery will be available to give lifts to corners from outside the restaurant at 08:30 each morning. Please drive slowly and carefully if making your own way to corner.

Circuit and Camping Entrance:

Access to the Marshals campsite can be gained from midday on Thursday 2nd May. But please be aware that access to the paddock and other areas of the circuit is NOT until 9pm, please say in the campsite prior to this as the circuit is kindly allowing us to arrive earlier on this proviso.

Marshals, Officials and Medics BBQ – Saturday night:

There will be a BBQ on the Saturday night, in the Marshals campsite. The Club will provide the food (usually burgers, sausages, cheese (if Gordon remembers because he doesn't like cheese) and buns, etc), and you just need to provide your own drink and any extras.


As usual, I would appreciate your help with unloading/loading the van and the putting up/taking down of the marquee and bbq. As always, a MASSIVE thank you to Gordon for his continued help with the BBQ.

Camping and Power:

The Marshals campsite is located on the outside of the circuit, behind the time-keepers hut and alongside the start line. To access the campsite, turn left immediately after you enter through the main entrance (ticket booths). Follow the track around the outside of the circuit to the far end... if you look to the right you should see the start line, if you don't, you're probably at the wrong circuit!!

Please note that there is VERY limited power available, and this should only be used to keep fridges going and for topping up batteries... please do not use it for anything else such as heaters etc as this could trip the power and ruin it for everyone else. The power pole is located behind the toilet cabin.

CAMPING OVERNIGHT SUNDAY: Providing you are camped in the designated Marshal camping area as marked on the map, you will be able to stay on Sunday night. You will need to vacate on Monday morning.
