Main Information:

- Signing on will take place in the Kentagon from 07:15 each day – Although please note that the circuit will be live from 09:00 on Friday and Saturday and 10:00 on Sunday! 😊
- Friday 30th you will receive breakfast and a cooked lunch in the circuit restaurant, and payment of £20
- Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd you will receive breakfast in the circuit restaurant and a packed lunch, and a payment of £10 for each day (**please note that this payment replaces any camping monies given previously**)
- **IO BRIEFING:** Briefing for all IOs at 08:15 on FRIDAY and SATURDAY mornings, where we sign-on

Circuit/Camping Entrance:

Access to the Marshals campsite only, can be gained via the Main Gate from lunch time on Thursday 29th September. Please note that access to the outer paddock and garages is from 18:00.

DON'T FORGET ... I will be awarding the Marshal of the Year 2022 trophy in the Kentagon on Sunday morning at 09:00 and I hope you will join me to congratulate the worthy winner!!

Parking and Getting to Corner:

You can get a lift to your corner from one of the recovery vans... pick up is from outside the Kentagon at approximately 08:30 Friday and Saturday and 09:30 on Sunday. Alternatively, you can park your car near most of the corners but please take care and keep your speed down if driving on circuit.

MARSHALS, OFFICIALS AND MEDICS BBQ – SATURDAY NIGHT:

There will be a BBQ on the Saturday night, in the Marshals campsite. The Club will provide the food (usually burgers, sausages, cheese and buns, etc), and you just need to provide your own drink and any extras.

A MASSIVE thank you to Gordon for his continued help with the BBQ. I'm sure you all join me in being forever grateful for all he does... his efforts provide an opportunity for those, who are so inclined, to gather socially together at the end of a day and share stories whilst munching on a sausage or two.

Camping and Power:

Camping will be available for Marshals, Medics and Officials in the Car Park on the left along Colin Chapman Way. Access to this is via the access road to the left of the toilet block and Kentagon. **Please do NOT camp anywhere else, or you WILL be asked to move.** Grass is available for tents.

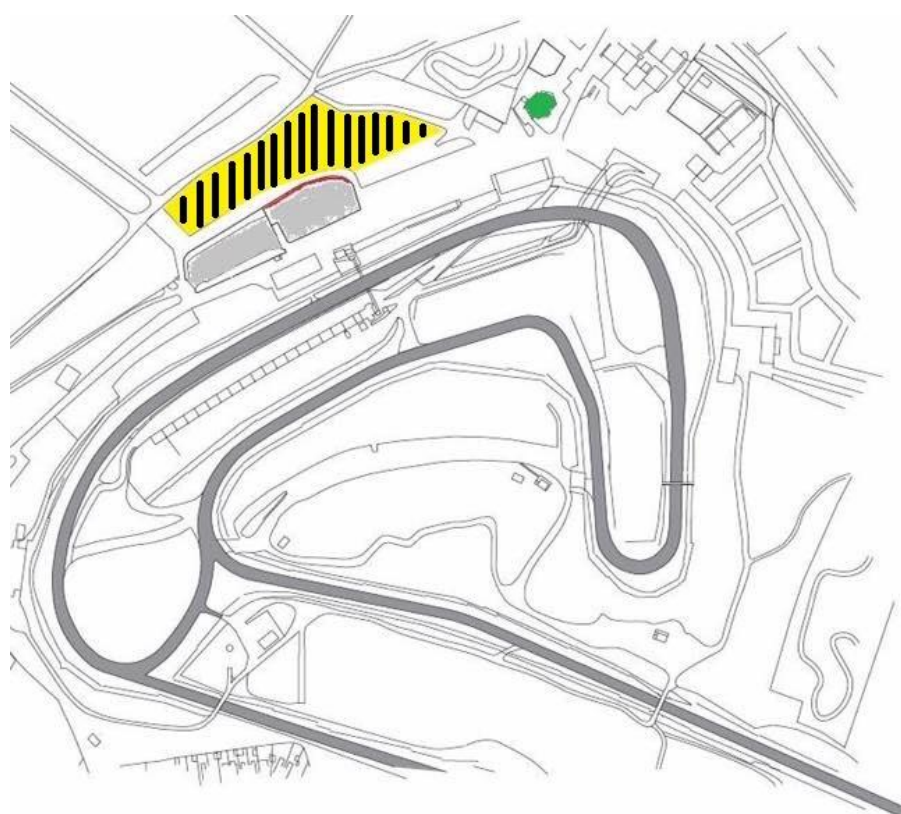
Entry to the campsite and outer paddock will be available from lunch time on Thursday 29th. There will be power available from the posts around the Expo site and you can run leads across the service road.


The Circuit Manager has asked us to emphasise that **ALL cables crossing the service road MUST have a cable protector covering them.** Anyone without a protector could find they are unplugged.

I have pressed for further toilets being available on the Thursday night without success. I appreciate how difficult this is and can only apologise that I couldn't do more. The main toilet block will be available from Friday PM and the usual disabled toilet from Thursday.

For those that are new to Marshalling or the power at Brands Hatch, you will need a 32A plug for the posts. Most of the regular Brands Marshals that camp over, have a 32A to Twin 16A adaptor, so if you find you're without the correct plug, please ask someone if they can help you out.

Marshals can camp on Sunday night but please leave the circuit on Monday morning.
