

F400 Classes:

Each class has its own championship,

1. F400 main class (M)
2. F400 sub 64 (S)
3. F400 Rookies (R). (no Sub 64 rookie)

F400 Main Class

- Trophies will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd place riders (irrespective of entry numbers)
- **Only F400 main class** riders can get positions/trophies in the **F400 main class** (rookies or **sub 64** riders can't get positions/trophies in **F400 main class** at race meetings)
- **F400 Sub 64** and **F400 Rookies** can score points in the **F400 main class** championship

F400 main class Summary/example:

- An **F400 Sub 64** rider or an **F400 Rookie** rider could win the **F400 main class** championship on points
- An **F400 sub 64** rider or an **F400 Rookie** rider cannot get trophies in the **F400 main class** at race meetings

F400 Sub 64

- Trophies will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd place riders (irrespective of entry numbers)
- The **F400 sub 64** class has its own championship.
- Riders have to opt in **sub 64** on sign on.
- Riders only get positions/trophies in the **F400 Sub 64** class at race meetings. (no position/trophies in the **F400 Main Class**)
- Riders can score points in **sub 64** and the **F400 main class** championships

Sub 64 Summary/ example:

- An **F400 sub 64** rider could win both the **f400 main class** and **F400 Sub 64** championships.
- An **F400 sub 64 rider** cannot get positions/trophies in the **F400 main class** at race meetings

F400 Rookie

- Trophies will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd place riders (irrespective of entry numbers)
- The **Rookie** class is its own championship irrespective of bike being used.
- Riders have to opt in **Rookie** on sign on – and should also indicate Sub-64 if that's the bike being used
- Riders only get positions/trophies in your own class at race meetings. (no position/trophies in the **Sub-64 or F400 Main Class**)
- Rookie Riders will score **points** in the **Rookie** as well as the Sub-64 (if their bike is eligible) and **F400 main class** championships

Rookie summary/example:

- An **F400 Rookie** rider could finish the race in first place but will only get a trophy for the **rookie class**, however they will get 25 points for the Rookie championship and 25 points for the F400 main class championship. (and points for Sub-64 if bike is eligible)
- An **F400 Rookie** rider could win both the **F400 Rookie** and **F400 main class** championships. (and Sub 64 if eligible)
- An **F400 Rookie** rider cannot get **trophies/positions** in the **F400 sub 64** or **F400 Main Class**

Class Notes:

- At race meetings trophies will be awarded accordingly at the end of the day on Saturday and by collection from the Race Office on Sunday.
- Championship points will be calculated within the week by timekeepers TSL Timing.
