

# Sidecar Taxi Rides:

## Brands Hatch 6-7 October 2018

### Passenger Information



Passengers whose entry has been received and who are then allocated a taxi ride will be published on the bemsee.net website. This list will be kept updated through to Wednesday 3rd October.

If you have sent an entry in but don't see your name on that list, please get in touch with the office on 01708 720305 prior to the meeting. We are unable to deal with late bookings at the circuit as we rarely have sufficient space on rides available.

**Please - you should book in advance and do not expect to be able to turn up and book in on the day.**

Circuit access will require an event ticket to enter the circuit on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> or Sunday 7<sup>th</sup>. These you must obtain at the gate or via a rider at the meeting if you are part of their team.

Please arrive at the circuit during the morning in time to cover the following:-

- You first need to attend the Race Office located under the Control Tower to "sign-on". (anytime from 10am)
- You will be issued with a coloured wristband for that day's event with your name marked on it, in exchange for your contribution to the BMCRC Benevolent Fund. (We ask for a minimum of £30)
- You will then be directed to visit the Technical Inspection Bay (in Garages 33-34) wearing the leathers & boots you will be using on the ride, take your gloves and helmet too.
- An Official will check your kit and will ask you to wear the helmet to check it fits. When all's Ok the Official will add a sticker to your wristband. You're ready to go!

On Saturday & Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>, lunch will be taken as near to 1pm as we can, although it is possible that incidents on track may cause some adjustment to the exact timings. Please listen out for paddock tannoy announcements that will keep you up to date.

The Taxi rides are planned to take place during the lunch period, so be ready in pitlane for 1pm please.

We will announce over the tannoy in advance that you should make your way to the pitlane to be ready for your ride. If you changed after your kit was inspected we recommend that you get into your gear before arriving at pitlane. The pitlane is accessed through the vehicle tunnel from the Outer Paddock, you should walk to the right hand side of the main building when you get to the far end of the tunnel road. Our pitlane staff will guide you to wait in a safe area at the end of the pitlane opposite the finishline.

Please ensure you continue to wear your correct coloured wristband (they are a different colour each day) and that the wristband has the Technical Sticker on it. This enables our pitlane staff to ensure you are signed on and kit-checked before you go out. Without this in place we will not be able to allow you to ride.

**It is not possible for us to arrange for you to ride a specific outfit – if you wish to ride a specific machine then please liaise with that team beforehand.**

We will call the sidecars to queue line astern in the pitlane at which time you will be invited forward to spend a short time with the team who will go over your seating position and handholds on the machine concerned.

Then you will be ready to go. Each ride will be for a minimum of 3 laps, an out-lap from pitlane, a flying lap and a return lap back into the pitlane.

After you've come back in, please move away from the pit area so we can allow other passengers to take their turn. Please ensure you carefully check both ways when crossing paddock roads as there will be bike and vehicle movements going on even during the lunch periods.
