Main Information:

- Signing on will take place in the Kentagon from 07:15 each day – Although please note that the circuit will be live from 09:00 on Friday and Saturday and 10:00 on Sunday!
- Friday you will receive a fully cooked breakfast in the Kentagon, **a packed lunch and a payment of £10 (instead of the previously given £20) ... please note that the packed lunch replaces the evening meal**
- Saturday and Sunday you will receive a fully cooked breakfast in the Kentagon and a packed lunch, and a payment of £10 for each day
- **IO BRIEFING:** Briefing for all IOs at 08:00 on FRIDAY and SATURDAY mornings, where we sign-on

Circuit/Camping Entrance:

Access to the Marshals campsite ONLY can be gained via the Main Gate from lunch time on Thursday 1st October. Please note that access to the paddock areas is not until 17:00 on the Thursday.

You can get a lift to your corner from one of the recovery vans... pick up is from outside the Kentagon at approximately 08:30 (Friday and Saturday) and 09:30 (Sunday). Alternatively, you can park your car near most of the corners or along Colin Chapman Way. Parking enfield, near the garages, is not permitted.

BBQ and Marshal of the Year 2026:

There will be a BBQ on the Saturday night, in the Marshals campsite. The Club will provide the food (usually burgers, sausages, cheese and buns, etc), and you just need to provide your own drink and any extras.

As usual, I would appreciate your help with unloading/loading the van and the putting up/taking down of the marquee and bbq.

A MASSIVE thank you to Gordon for his continued help with the BBQ. I'm sure you all join me in being forever grateful for all he does... his efforts provide an opportunity for those, who are so inclined, to gather socially together at the end of a day and share stories whilst munching on a sausage or two.

Camping and Power:

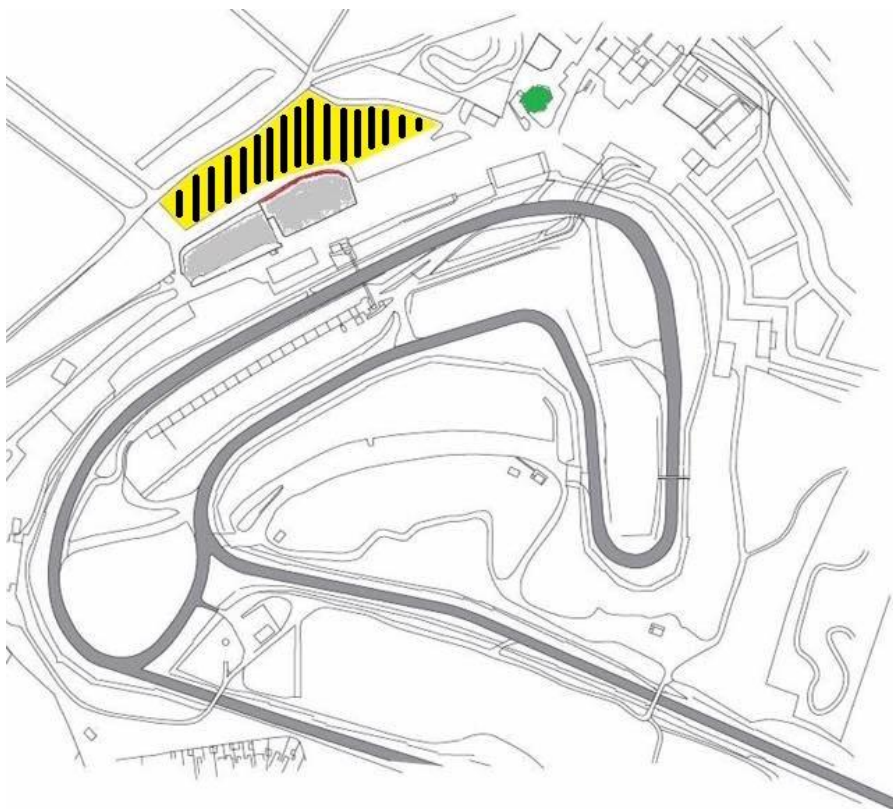
Camping will be available for Marshals, Medics and Officials in the Car Park on the left along Colin Chapman Way. Access to this is via the access road to the left of the toilet block and Kentagon. **Please do NOT camp anywhere else, or you WILL be asked to move.** Grass is available for tents.

Entry to the campsite and outer paddock will be available from lunchtime on Thursday 14th March. There will be power available from the posts around the Expo site and you can run leads across the service road.

The Circuit Manager has asked us to emphasise that **ALL cables crossing the service road MUST have a cable protector covering them.** Anyone without a protector could find they are unplugged.

For those that are new to Marshalling or the power at Brands Hatch, you will need a 32A plug for the posts. Most of the regular Brands Marshals that camp over, have a 32A to Twin 16A adaptor, so if you find you're without the correct plug, please ask someone if they can help you out.

Marshals can camp on Sunday night but please leave the circuit on Monday morning.
